

8. SHORTLAND STREET: BUS STOP

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to extend the length of the bus stop in Shortland Street by the entrance to Aranui High School.

The Deputy Principal of Aranui High School has requested that the existing bus stop located by the school entrance in Shortland Street be extended to accommodate two buses. On a daily basis two buses that serve both Chisnallwood School and Aranui High School use this area to transfer students from one bus to another. The extension of the existing bus stop will provide a safer area to transfer students between buses.

The extension will also allow buses to park clear of the school entrance, providing a clearer view of south bound traffic on Shortland Street for pedestrians attempting to cross the road.

Environment Canterbury is agreeable to the extension of this bus stop.

- Recommendations:**
1. That the existing 'Bus Stop 8 am - 4 pm Monday to Friday' on the north east side of Shortland Street commencing at a point 116 metres north west of McHaffies Place and extending in a north westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres, be revoked.
 2. That a 'Bus Stop 8 am - 4 pm Monday to Friday' be installed on the north east side of Shortland Street commencing at a point 101 metres north west of McHaffies Place and extending in a north westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.

Chairperson's Recommendation: That the abovementioned recommendations be adopted.
