

8. FERRY ROAD (BETWEEN BARBOUR AND GRAFTON STREETS) - PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to a parking restriction being imposed for a distance between Barbour and Grafton Streets.

The takeaway business and the secondhand dealer on Ferry Road in the centre of the block between Grafton and Barbour Streets, are experiencing difficulty with vehicles being parked for long periods of time outside their businesses. Both businesses are reliant on this parking being available for their customers. The businesses either side have on-site customer parking available but this is not possible for either the takeaway or secondhand business.

The restriction is along the business frontage and does not restrict parking or access to any other property.

The proposed restriction is consistent with what is in the area and has the support of the two businesses and the Parking Manager.

The Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board has also considered the report and supports the recommendation below.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum of 10 minutes on the south side of Ferry Road commencing at a point 48 metres from its intersection with Barbour Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the above recommendation be adopted.
