

7. FERRY ROAD (CORNER OF SMITH STREET) - PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to a parking restriction being imposed at the corner of Smith Street.

The florist on the corner of Ferry Road and Smith Street is experiencing difficulty with vehicles being parked for long periods of time outside the business. This small business is reliant on passing traffic to be profitable.

The restriction is along the business frontage and does not restrict parking or access to any other property.

The proposed restriction is consistent with what is in the area and has the support of the adjacent business and the Parking Manager.

The Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board has also considered this report and supports the recommendation below.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum of 30 minutes on the north side of Ferry Road commencing at a point 8 metres from its intersection with Smith Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 11 metres.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the above recommendation be adopted.
