13. WITHELLS ROAD - PROPOSED NO STOPPING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to inform the Board that it is proposed to install a no-stopping restriction on the east side of Withells Road from Brookby Crescent to the southern boundary of No.202 Withells Road. Withells Road is a collector road therefore the proposed work will be submitted to the City Services Committee for approval in due course.

BACKGROUND

Following two minor accidents, requests have been received from No.202 Withells Road (a Caltex Service Station) and the corner property (No.19 Brookby Crescent) for a no stopping restriction on the east side of Withells Road along the full length of the frontage of both these and the intermediate property. The installation of this restriction will improve visibility for drivers exiting Brookby Crescent (which also serves as an entrance/exit to Avonhead Mall) and the Service Station.

In the interests of road safety, the intermediate property (No.204 Withells Road) between the above properties is also in favour of this restriction. Withells Road carries an average of 6,000 vehicles per day.

PROPOSAL

It is proposed that the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the east side of Withells Road commencing at its intersection with Brookby Crescent and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of eighty-seven metres.
