The purpose of this report is to advise the Committee of the Creative Places Award won by the Council for the “Living Streets” redevelopment of Peverel Street.

The Creative Places Award was established in 1999 by Creative New Zealand to acknowledge the key role that local authorities play in the arts.

Peverel Street is Christchurch’s first “Living Street” and incorporates a water feature, glass tiles based on paintings by children, meandering footpath and seating well.

The award was in the urban landscape design category and the actual prize is on display in the ground floor foyer.
