

**8. FERRY ROAD: GIVE WAY SIGN**

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to install a “Give Way” sign in Ferry Road at the intersection with St Asaph Street.

Ferry Road at this point has a Local road status intersecting with St Asaph – a Minor arterial.

Concern has been expressed by commuters with regard to traffic movements at this intersection. Vehicles west bound on Ferry Road currently have no formalised limit lines to gauge their position in relation to this intersection which has an obtuse angle. The result is that many vehicles are stopping to give way within the actual intersection causing concern to vehicles following them on Ferry Road and particularly to St Asaph Street traffic.

The installation of a “Give Way” sign with limit lines will improve the safety at this intersection.

**Recommendation:** That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Ferry Road at its intersection with St Asaph Street.

**Chairman’s Recommendation:** That the recommendations be adopted.
