

6. MOBILE LIBRARY STOPS

This report is to gain Board approval for the removal of two bus stops for the mobile library.

As part of the review of the Mobile Libraries Service, two stops in the Hagley / Ferrymead Ward are to be disestablished. These stops do not meet the customer and issues per hour of service benchmarks.

The stops are in Gloucester Street, north of Woodham Road by the shopping area and in Keighleys Road near the Bromley School.

- Recommendation:**
1. That the mobile library stop on the west side of Gloucester Street commencing at a point 37 metres from its intersection with Woodham Road and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 15 metres be removed.
 2. That the mobile library stop on the north side of Keighleys Road commencing at a point 102 metres from its intersection with Korora Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 15 metres be removed.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the recommendations be adopted.
