### PAPANUI YOUTH FACILITY

Unfortunately the property in Restell Street which the Papanui Youth Network had been negotiating for use as a Youth Facility is not available. It is understood that another party signed up for the property during these negotiations. The Network group is continuing to investigate suitable properties. Funding has been provided both by the Board and the Council towards a youth facility and this is still available for the project.
