The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the City Services Committee the installation of “Give Way” signs in Bower Avenue and Broadhaven Avenue at the new roundabout.

The new subdivision located to the north west of Bower Avenue and the eastern end of Broadhaven Avenue is now being opened for housing development. As part of the subdivision development “Give Way” controls were installed at the new roundabout at the intersection of Bower Avenue and Broadhaven Avenue.

These “Give Way” signs will remove the confusion between right turning vehicles and make the intersections safer.

Recommendation: That the Board recommends to the City Services Committee that it approve the installation of the following “Give Way” controls:

1. That a “Give Way” sign be placed against the Bower Avenue southern approach to its intersection with Broadhaven Avenue.
2. That a “Give Way” sign be placed against the Bower Avenue northern approach to its intersection with Broadhaven Avenue.
3. That a “Give Way” sign be placed against the Broadhaven Avenue western approach to its intersection with Bower Avenue.

Chairperson’s Recommendation: That the abovementioned recommendation be approved.
