The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of the feedback from residents, on the naming of Hulverstone Drive.

In 1999 a survey was carried out to find out if the residents wished a street name change for Hulverstone Drive at the time it would be split into two separate sections by ANZAC Drive. The result of the questionnaire indicated that the name Hulverstone Drive should remain. This response was reported to the Board at its meeting on 31 January 2000.

The Community Board decided that, "the renaming of Hulverstone Drive be readdressed in 12 months time".

A questionnaire was distributed to the residents of Hulverstone Drive during February 2001 to find out whether they preferred that, "the name remain Hulverstone Drive" or that "a name change be considered".

The results of this review indicated that 93% of the residents preferred that the name Hulverstone Drive remain. However, the New Brighton Voluntary Fire Brigade have expressed a preference for two names on a street, which is divided like Hulverstone Drive by ANZAC Drive, to assist in identifying the quickest route to a fire scene.

**Recommendation:** That the Board approve the retention of the name Hulverstone Drive.
