The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Parks and Recreation Committee that the large pond at the southern end of Barkers Waterway be named Lake Kate Sheppard and the waterway and pond along the western margin of the Woolston/Burwood Expressway be named Erickson Waterway.

BACKGROUND

At the Board's meeting in January it was identified that further investigation was required of the naming of features within the green corridor. The descendants of the Erickson family have requested recognition of their past involvement and ownership of land in this area. The opportunity exists to recognise the Erickson family by calling the complex of waterways and small pond along the western margin of the Woolston/Burwood Expressway, Erickson Waterway. The naming of this waterway is consistent with the naming of the eastern waterway after the other local landowning and farming family, that is the Barkers Waterway.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to the Parks and Recreation Committee:

- 1. That the waterway and pond along the western margin of the Woolston/Burwood Expressway from New Brighton Road to Travis Road be named Erickson Waterway.
- 2. That the large pond at the southern end of Barkers Waterway and directly north of New Brighton Road be named Lake Kate Sheppard.
