

35. TRAVIS ROAD: ROAD MARKINGS

The purpose of this report is to seek the approval of the City Services Committee to the formalising of road markings in Travis Road opposite Blue Gum Place.

In response to concerns raised for traffic safety at the intersection of Travis Road with Blue Gum Place, it is considered appropriate to prohibit the stopping of vehicles at any time, on the north side of Travis Road at this location.

As part of a city wide scheme to improve traffic flows on arterial roads it is proposed to install side lines along Travis Road, and the banning of vehicles in this area would be part of that work.

It is now appropriate to approve the installation of the road markings.

The matter was also considered at the 29 January 2001 meeting of the Burwood/Pegasus Community Board. The Board decided:

That a report be requested from the City Streets Unit on the road markings in Beach Road and the "Palms" mall area, particularly Marshland Road and Golf Links Road, to enable the Board to review where the car markings are placed.

Recommendation: That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the north side of Travis Road commencing at its intersection with the Queen Elizabeth II Park entrance and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 50 metres.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the above recommendation be adopted.
