17. CHESTER STREET P120 PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to create a P120 parking restriction on the northern side of Chester Street outside the Crichton Cobbers Youth Club.

The club, located on the northwestern corner of the Chester Street/Fitzgerald Avenue intersection, is experiencing problems with the area outside the club rooms being used for commuter and long term parking. The club, which has been in existence since 1927, has a wide range of members that include children and adults from both sexes. The functions of the club covers a wide range of fitness activities from boxing, and martial arts to weight lifting. They have asked that a parking restriction be put in place to enable their members and other visitors to the street find convenient roadside parking. They have no ability to provide any off street parking onsite. There are no immediate parking restrictions in this area.

The proposed parking restriction is supported by the Parking Manager who has also requested that a motor cycle area be provided to overcome the problem of motorcycles parked on the foot path.

Recommendations:

- 1. That a parking restriction with a time limit of 120 minutes is created on the northern side of Chester Street commencing at a point 25 metres measured in a westerly direction from a point opposite the western kerbline of Fitzgerald Street and extending in an westerly direction for a distance of 46 metres.
- 2. That a motorcycle parking area be created on the northern side of Chester Street commencing at a point 71 metres measured in a westerly direction from a point opposite the western kerbline of Fitzgerald Street and extending in an westerly direction for a distance of 6 metres.
