

19. WASHINGTON WAY P60 PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to create a P60 parking restriction on the northern side of Washington Way.

Washington Way is a short local road that runs between Moorhouse Avenue and Gasson Street. The street is now nearly fully developed and problems are being experienced the street being used for commuter and student parking. There have been numerous requests for a short term parking restriction to allow visitors to the medical facilities, state board area and for servicing of business. It is proposed to introduce a P60 parking restriction on the north side of the street.

This proposed restriction is supported by the Parking Operations Manager.

Recommendation: That a parking restriction with a time limit of 60 minutes be created on the northern side Washington Way commencing at a point 73 metres measured in an easterly direction from a point opposite the eastern kerbline of Gasson Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 42 metres.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the officer's recommendation be adopted.
