

9. COLOMBO STREET – TIME LIMIT PARKING AT COMMUNITY CENTRE

The purpose of this report is to seek the Boards approval for the installation of a P120 Loading Zone in front of the St Albans Community Resource Centre at 1049 Colombo Street.

The kerbside area in this block of Colombo Street to the south of the Edgeware shopping centre is usually full with long-term parking. The St Albans Community Resource Centre has very limited space for on-site parking. The staff at the centre have requested that a time limit parking zone be created across part of the frontage of the site to provide turnover parking for visitors.

The proposed recommendation would provide two parking spaces for vehicles. P120 is appropriate in this instance as it will prevent all-day parking at this location. The space would be available for long term parking after hours.

As this part of Colombo Street is classified a Collector road, the Board's recommendation will be referred to the Council for resolution.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 120 minutes on the western side of Colombo Street commencing at a point 101 metres north of the northern kerb with Canon Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.

Chairperson's Recommendation: That the officer's recommendation be adopted subject to residents approval.
