The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to install a "Give Way" sign in Kingsford Street at the intersection with New Brighton Road.

Concern has been expressed by residents with regard to traffic movements at the intersection of Kingsford Street and New Brighton Road. Right of way between right turning vehicles at the intersection is the problem. This would be solved if a "Give Way" sign was erected against traffic entering the intersection from Kingsford Street.

This concern was also identified in the Shirley East Local Area Traffic Management Scheme. New Brighton Road has a Minor Arterial road status with an average daily traffic count of 16,300 vehicles.

The installation of a "Give Way" sign will improve the safety at this intersection.

Recommendation: That a "Give Way" sign be placed against Kingsford Street at its intersection with New

Brighton Road.
