

**9. PUTAKE DRIVE/PUHARA AVENUE/TANU PLACE: GIVE WAY SIGNS**

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to install “Give Way” signs in Putake Drive at the intersection with Mairehau Road, and Puhara Avenue/Tanu Place at the intersections with Putake Drive.

The new ‘Temara Park’ subdivision north east of the Burwood Hospital is due to open for housing development in late January 2001. The construction plans for this new subdivision show “Give Way” controls on Putake Drive at Mairehau Road, and Puhara Avenue/Tanu Place at Putake Drive.

These “Give Way” signs will remove the confusion between right turning vehicles and make the intersections safer. It also gives Mairehau Road (a Minor Arterial) the priority.

- Recommendations:**
1. That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Putake Drive at its intersection with Mairehau Road.
  2. That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Puhara Avenue at its intersection with Putake Drive.
  3. That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Tanu Place at its intersection with Putake Drive.

**Chairperson’s Recommendation:** That the abovementioned recommendation be adopted.
