#### **33.1 Six Monthly Review of Hagley/Ferrymead Board Objectives and Performance Indicators**

It is proposed that a six monthly review of the 2000/2001 Board Objectives and Performance Indicators will take place at the workshops on 14/21 February when the Board will confirm its Objectives and Performance Indicators for 20001/2002.

#### **33.2 Coast to Coast Cycle Route**

The concept of a Coast to Coast cycle route has been circulating amongst cycle advocates and cycle tourists for a number of years. The Council has recently become interested in developing the concept further after observing the range of tremendous benefits that the UK's 5000 km cycle network has brought to local communities. Hopefully the Coast to Coast cycle route would be one of the initial elements of a national cycle network.

The Hagley/Ferrymead area has been identified as one that could potentially be impacted or may wish to be involved further in this project, hence Board members are invited to attend a meeting and hear about the project concept.

The meeting is to be held in the Ballroom of the Centra Hotel, Cashel Street, Christchurch, at 7pm on the evening of Monday, 19 February 2001, hosted by Councillor Denis O'Rourke, chair of the City Services Committee.
