

8. NURSERY ROAD – GIVE WAY

The purpose of this report is to gain Board approval for the installation of a “Give Way” control against Nursery Road at Tuam Street.

The kerb and channel in the section of Nursery Road from Cashel Street to Tuam Street is due to be renewed this year. One of the issues raised in the scheme plan safety audit was the need for a control to be installed at the intersection of Nursery Road and Tuam Street.

Some confusion for traffic turning right from Tuam Street into the northern section of Nursery is occurring. Tuam Street is a minor arterial and carries a large volume of traffic. The northern and southern sections of Nursery Road are offset at this intersection. Allowing Tuam Street traffic the right of way will remove waiting traffic from the intersection.

A “Give Way” control against Nursery Road will improve safety at the intersection and remove any confusion for right turning traffic from either road.

Recommendation : That a “Give Way” sign be placed against the northern section of Nursery Road at its intersection with Tuam Street.

Chairman’s Recommendation: That the officer’s recommendation be adopted.
