

## 9. TAUPATA STREET – GIVE WAY

The purpose of this report is to gain Board approval for the installation of a “Give Way” control against Taupata Street at Main Road.

Part of the work to be carried out in Main Road to provide a safe pedestrian refuge crossing point includes narrowing the intersection at Taupata street and decreasing the width that children have to cover to cross Taupata Street.

A safety audit of the scheme plan highlighted the need for a control to be installed against Taupata Street.

Main Road is a minor arterial and carries a large volume of traffic. Taupata is a local road that serves as access to the some community facilities.

A “Give Way” control against Taupata Street will improve safety at the intersection and will allow waiting traffic on Main Road to clear the intersection quickly.

**Recommendation:** That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Taupata Street at its intersection with Main Road.

**Chairman’s Recommendation:** That the officer’s recommendation be adopted.
