The purpose of this report is to present the draft Redwood West Local Area Traffic Management Scheme to the Community Board and gain approval to circulate it to the public for comment. (A copy of the LATMS and a copy of the summary document is circulated under separate cover to Board members).

As a result of a petition from the residents of Uxbridge Street and to encourage public participation in the LATMS process a meeting was held in the Northcote School hall on 22 March 2000. A large number of concerned residents and Board Members attended to consider traffic safety improvements for inclusion in the LATMS. Other issues raised are also outlined in the list of concerns in the draft plan.

The LATMS has been prepared by the City Streets Unit in close consultation with the Environmental Policy and Planning Unit and Parks Unit.

An article on the Redwood West Local Area Traffic Management Scheme may also be included in the local newspaper.
