

4. CLIFFORD STREET – PROPOSED GIVE WAY SIGN

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board’s approval for a Give Way sign to be installed against Clifford Avenue at its uncontrolled intersection with Fendalton Road.

The situation is that there are adequate sight distances in both directions along Fendalton Road for a driver doing a right turn from Clifford Avenue. However there is some confusion over turning priorities when a vehicle from Fendalton Road (a major arterial carrying 20,000 vehicles per day) and a vehicle from Clifford Avenue (a local road carrying approximately 400 vehicles per day) wish to turn right at the same time. The most appropriate way to remove the confusion would be to install a Give Way sign against Clifford Avenue as recommended in the New Zealand Land Transport’s manual of regulatory signs and markings.

Recommendation: That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Clifford Avenue at its intersection with Fendalton Road.

Chairman’s Recommendation: That the foregoing recommendation be adopted.
