

16. PROPOSED NEW ROAD AND RIGHT OF WAY NAMES

The purpose of this report is to obtain the approval by the Board of new road and right of way names.

WAI/20002289 Roydvale Developments Limited Teesdale Street Waimairi Ward

The Board will recall approving the name Ashby Close at the last meeting on 5 June. This subdivision included a small cul de sac off Teesdale Street, and a formed right of way off Roydvale Avenue.

For some reason, the computer check failed to show the existence of the existing road Ashby Place in the Fendalton Ward. Confusion would arise if the new name Ashby Close was retained. The developers have now proposed the following names, some of which are in keeping with the name Teesdale. The names submitted are all villages or towns in close proximity to the River Tees in north east England. Deepdale Street which runs off Teesdale Street also takes it's name from the same locality. **Bowbank, Thornaby** (from the River Tees) **Highwood, Bellbird Casey** and **Maree** (background to the latter two names is not known). The right of way is to be called "Lane" in keeping with Council's Policy on naming.

Recommendation: That the right of way off Roydvale Avenue be Called **Highwood** or **Bellbird Lane**, and the cul de sac off Teesdale Street **Bowbank** or **Thornaby Close**
