

## 10. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES WORKING PARTY: MEMBERSHIP

Chairperson, **Environment** Committee or his/her nominee and **two** other elected representatives  
**Urban Form Policy Leader**  
A representative from the Parks **and Waterways** Unit, CCC  
A representative of the Tangata Whenua  
A representative from the School of Fine Arts, Canterbury  
A representative from the Christchurch Polytechnic  
Curator, Robert McDougall Art Gallery  
An artist/sculptor resident in Christchurch  
A representative of the Canterbury Branch of the Institute of Architects  
Community Arts Adviser(s)”*
