6. BRENCHLEY AVENUE/COLLEGE AVENUE/URUNGA AVENUE/WATFORD STREET – PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to advise the Board of the results of a parking restriction survey in the above streets.

A request was received from residents in College Avenue and Urunga Avenue at their Normans Road ends that the Council install parking restrictions in their streets. To address the existing parking issues and the area they are likely to migrate too (if restrictions are installed), a survey was made of the full length of Brenchley Avenue, and in College Avenue, Urunga Avenue, and Watford Street from Normans Road to Brenchley Avenue. The survey advised that restrictions would provide on-street parking for residents on one side as well as for St Andrews College users on the other side during the school term.

In response to the survey, 53 replies were received, 25 supported some form of parking restriction, and 28 were against any parking restriction. Some respondents gave a parking restriction option other than those in the survey. The following are the results of the survey: -

- A sixty-minute parking restriction (3).
- A two-hour parking restriction (recommended as best in this situation) (16).
- No restriction at all in the street (28).

Of those who desired a parking restriction, the requested times of operation were as follows: -

- The restriction to apply Monday to Friday inclusive (22).
- The restriction to apply seven days a week (2).

There was total disagreement as to the preferred side of the streets the restriction should operate on.

As there is majority support for 'no restriction at all in the street', no further action is therefore proposed.

Recommendation: That the information be received.
