

8. CUTTS ROAD – PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve the installation of a three minute parking restriction outside Russley School.

A request has been received from the Russley School that "...the Council place official signs outside the school which indicate parking for three minutes. The times on the signs are to read between 8.30 – 9.00 am and 2.45 – 3.15 pm Monday to Friday".

The reason for the request was that parents of school pupils have reported difficulty in picking up and dropping off their children.

A parking survey was distributed in April to affected properties. The responses are as follows: -

• Unconditionally for the proposal	6

To improve the parking situation when parents are dropping off or picking up their children from school it is proposed that a three minute parking restriction be installed which would operate for the times outlined above.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of three minutes from 8.30 to 9.00 a.m. and 2.45 to 3.15 p.m. from Monday to Friday on the west side of Cutts Road commencing at a point 3.5 metres from the northern boundary of No. 79 and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 30.5 metres.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the foregoing recommendation be adopted.
