The purpose of this report is to advise the Board of feedback to the publicity plan showing the construction of pedestrian islands in Grahams Road and Greers Road both of which are collector roads.

At its meeting on 3 April 2001, the Board approved the publicity plan showing the position of the proposed pedestrian islands for distribution. Feedback from the residents to the publicity plan was: -

One of those against the proposal is the owner of No. 399 Greers Road who has objected to the location of the pedestrian island near Eastling Street on the grounds that it would be impossible to turn right into his driveway. This is correct, but in this position he is the only property so affected. At a site meeting with the resident it was confirmed that this position was best in the Area Engineer's view.

Several objections were also received regarding the positioning of the pedestrian island between Condell Avenue and Kilburn Street.

The Area Engineer shall hold further discussions with the residents concerned and report back to the Board.
