The purpose of this report is to inform Committee members of the Certificate of Appreciation awarded to the Council.

On Friday 25 May 2001, the Christchurch City Council was awarded a Certificate of Appreciation for its support of the Indian Film Industry.

On behalf of Trade New Zealand, Deputy Prime Minister, the Rt Hon Jim Anderton, presented an Export Commendation to Kuran New Zealand Ltd and Certificates of Appreciation to key players encouraging film makers to bring their productions to New Zealand.
