3. YALDHURST ROAD/RACECOURSE ROAD INTERSECTION

At the 16 March 2001 meeting of this Committee it was agreed that City Streets be asked to undertake a further traffic count, as the question in traffic signal installation at this intersection was still a current community issue.

The Committee asked, also, that there be a review of the cost benefit analysis of putting traffic lights in at this intersection, taking into account the benefits to the wider area.
