

6. WINCHESTER STREET – KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL - UPDATE

The purpose of this report is to advise the Board of the feedback received on the publicity plan showing the proposed kerb and dish channel layout on the east side of Winchester Street from Rugby Street to Merivale Lane.

Arising from the distribution of a publicity plan to the local residents in March, thirteen responses were received. Ten expressed strong support for the proposal, two were uncommitted, and a joint letter sent in by three residents objected to more grass berms and trees.

The proposed street trees are Golden Rain which are the same as the existing trees on the western side of the road.

An amount of \$120,000 has been budgeted for the work and the estimated cost of this proposal is \$98,000.

Having gained the majority support for Winchester Street to have its kerb and channel renewed on the east side from Rugby Street to Merivale Lane, construction plans will now be prepared.

Recommendation: That the information be received.
