

9. NAMING OF RESERVES – SALISBURY STREET AND STANMORE ROAD

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Council that four areas of land be named.

On 2 August 2000 the Board resolved:

- **Stanmore Road/Tuam Street Reserve**
That the name *Essex Reserve* be recommended to the Parks and Recreation Committee for this reserve.
- **Nursery Road Reserve**
That it be recommended to the City Streets Unit that this area of land which is at present legal road be named *Welcome Rest* and have its status formalised as a reserve.

84 Stanmore Road

That the name *Cambridge Green* be recommended to the Parks and Recreation Committee for this reserve.

The Parks and Waterways Unit and Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board has been waiting for a response from a letter to Mr Patrick Holland, the son of Doris Lusk after whom one of the reserves will be named. No response has been received.

That the name *Essex Reserve* be given to this reserve.

That this area of land which is at present legal road be named *Welcome Rest* and have its status formalised as a reserve.
 - 3. 84 Stanmore Road**
That the name *Doris Lusk Corner* be given to this reserve.
 - 4. Salisbury Street Reserve**
That the name *Cambridge Green* be given to this reserve.
