The purpose of this report is to update the Community Board on the Turning Point 2000 State Highway One landscape enhancement project.

The Board may recall that the project was introduced to them at their October 1999 meeting. Since then, tree and rose planting has been completed at Belfast and Sawyers Arms Road roundabout.

This year it is anticipated to undertake the following landscaping enhancement:

- Installation of Christchurch entry sign at the Main North Road and Northern Motorway intersection in Belfast. This sign will be the same as that at Templeton and on the West Coast Road. Planting in the vicinity of sign's location has already been undertaken.
- The planting of the currently paved median with ground cover roses at the northern end of the highway at Belfast.
- Tree planting on John's Road from the Groynes and Clearwater Resort to Sawyers Arms Road.

This planting will be in place by early August this year.
