

14. BENTLEY STREET – PROPOSED GIVE WAY CONTROL

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board recommends to the Council the installation of a Give Way control to be installed against Bentley Street at its uncontrolled intersection with Cutts Road.

The situation is that there is some confusion over turning priorities when a vehicle from Cutts Road (a collector road carrying 3,600 vehicles per day) and a vehicle from Bentley Street (a local road carrying approximately 1,300 vehicles per day) wish to turn right at the same time.

The most appropriate way to remove the confusion is to install a Give Way sign against Bentley Street as recommended in the New Zealand Land Transport's manual of regulatory signs and markings.

Recommendation: That it be recommended to the Council that a Give Way control be installed against Bentley Street at its intersection with Cutts Road.
