Reserves Hearings	 To hear submissions form the community on Reserves Management Plans. Membership to comprise all Board members, a quorum of three, to serve on a rostered basis.
Fendalton/Waimairi Strengthening Communities (SCAP) Committee	 A joint Committee comprising community and Board representatives. In accordance with a resolution from the 31 July 2001 Board meeting, 4 Board representatives are required.
