

24. CASHEL STREET – PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to install a P30 parking restriction in Cashel Street.

A request was received asking that an investigation be carried out into the possibility of placing a parking restriction outside three businesses in Cashel Street between Barbadoes Street and Fitzgerald Avenue. Two of the businesses have customer parking and staff parking in front of their buildings but the third business has no off-street parking. This business, Sky TV, has a lot of customers who only stay a short time and they are inclined to park over driveways or double park in the traffic lane.

At present this section of Cashel Street is used as commuter parking. As this was an urgent request a P30 restriction was installed. It is in keeping with the other parking restriction in this area. By keeping parking restrictions in an area all of a similar time limit makes it easier for the Parking Unit to administer.

If the board resolves that the parking restriction is not required or is of the wrong time duration it will be removed or altered.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to the Council that the parking of vehicles be restricted to 30 minutes on the north side of Cashel Street commencing at a point 154 metres from its intersection with Barbadoes Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance 51 metres.
