

## 26. FITZGERALD AVENUE – PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to install a parking restriction on Fitzgerald Avenue between Chester Street and Kilmore Street.

The businesses on the west side of Fitzgerald Avenue were having difficulty with customer car parking. This section of Fitzgerald Avenue was all day parking and was regularly parked out by commuter traffic.

To help these businesses stay viable a P60 parking restriction has been put in place and will be removed if the Board feel that is inappropriate.

**Recommendation:** That the Board recommend to the Council that the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum of 60 minutes on the west side of Fitzgerald Avenue commencing at a point 7.5 metres from its intersection with Chester Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 65 metres.
