

27. HEBERDEN AVENUE – PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to install a no parking restriction in Heberden Avenue.

Problems have been experienced in Heberden Avenue with traffic travelling on the wrong side of the road when using this road. To help eliminate some of the problems that are occurring a centre line has been placed at the approach and departures of all intersections.

In discussion with some of the residents in the area, concerns were also raised about the narrowness of the section of Heberden Avenue between Colenso and Arnold Streets. After some investigation it was agreed that a parking ban in this area, along the eastern side (hill side) would increase safety.

Local residents canvassed the properties that will be effected by this decision and the majority are in favour. They have also been notified by way of a flyer, that this parking ban is being recommended to the Board.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to the Council that the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the eastern side of Heberden Avenue commencing at a point 10 metres north of its intersection with Colenso Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 169 metres.
