

30. MARRINER STREET – BUS STOP

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to extend the bus stop in Marriner Street at Nayland Street.

As part of the construction work to be carried out in Nayland Street there is a kerb build out in Marriner Street, this intrudes into the existing bus stop in Marriner Street. For this stop to operate properly and the bus not intrude into the traffic lane, it is necessary to extend the bus stop south easterly for 6 metres.

The residents and property owner have been contacted.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to the Council:

1. That the bus stop on the north eastern side of Marriner Street commencing at a point 5 metres from its intersection with Nayland Street and extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres be removed.
2. That a bus stop be installed on the north eastern side of Marriner Street commencing at a point 11 metres from its intersection with Nayland Street and extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
