

32. PETERBOROUGH STREET - RESIDENTS PARKING

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to approve the restriction of parking in two places in Peterborough Street to residents only parking.

At present there is a residents only parking space in Peterborough Street outside No. 212 but with the new kerb and channel work and the road narrowing at the intersection with Madras Street, this park will have to be moved. The residents at this address do not have any off-street parking and have requested that this park be reinstated.

As part of the consultation for the street works a second request was received for a residents park. This request meets the criteria of no off-street parking, no facility for off-street parking and no garaging facilities in the neighbourhood.

The area is used as commuter parking and residents find it difficult to park near their homes. Several residents have no or very limited parking on their properties. The creation of two residents only parking spaces will help elevate some of the problems residents are experiencing.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to the Council:

1. That the residents only car park on the south side of Peterborough Street commencing at a point 15.5 metres from its intersection with Madras and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 6 metres be removed.
2. That a residents only car park be created on the south side of Peterborough Street commencing at a point 21.5 metres from its intersection with Madras Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 6 metres.
3. That a residents only car park be created on the south side of Peterborough Street commencing at a point 57.5 metres from its intersection with Madras Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 6 metres.
