

15. LIQUOR LICENCE APPLICATIONS

The purpose of this report is to request the Board to appoint representatives of the Board to consider liquor licence applications, and make submissions to the Liquor Licensing Authority on behalf of Council, if necessary.

Applications for alcoholic liquor on-licences, off-licences and club licences, or for variations to these licences, are referred to the Spreydon-Heathcote Community Board for comment before being considered by the Liquor Licensing Authority in Wellington. In the past, the Board has delegated to two of its members the task of vetting these applications and determining whether to make a submission to the Liquor Licensing Authority if this seems appropriate.

Recommendation: That the Board nominate two of its members to consider liquor licence applications, and to make submissions to the Liquor Licensing Authority on behalf of the Council, if deemed necessary.
