The purpose of this report is to inform the Committee of arrangements in place for the official opening of the Hornby Courts Community Housing Complex.

BACKGROUND

The Hornby Housing project was initially proposed in January 1998. An extensive consultation process was undertaken with the community during 1998 and 1999. The complex is built on a 1.8930ha site bounded by Goulding Avenue and the Main South Road. The site was previously held by the Paparua County Council.

The complex comprises 22 units (9 @ 1 bedroom; 13 @ 2 bedrooms), of which two were specifically designed for occupation by people with physical disabilities. Also incorporated into the complex is an 80m² residents' lounge/community facility.

Tenanting of the complex commenced in June 2001, and currently all units have been allocated.

OPENING ARRANGEMENTS

The official opening ceremony is scheduled for Saturday 15 September, commencing at 2.30pm. The Hon Mark Gosche, Minister of Housing, has agreed to officially open the complex. A commemorative plaque has been commissioned for unveiling during the ceremony.
