The purpose of this report is to enable the Board to provide input into the process relating to a request received for the installation of telecommunications equipment on Council property in Burnside Park.

As members will be aware the Council has recently agreed to a programme for processing such requests, with final reports and recommendations to be considered by the Council's Cell Sites subcommittee. In the event of the subcommittee agreeing to the issue of a licence to a telecommunication company it will be noted that this will then be subject to the particular company obtaining a publicly notified resource consent, or a Reserve Act consent, both of which provide for public submissions to be made.

In the event of the Board agreeing to the principle for approval, it may care to consider any conditions which should be applied to such approval.
