The purpose of this report is to present the draft Bromley Local Traffic Management Scheme (LATMS) to the Board and gain approval to circulate it to the public for comment. (A copy of the summary document is circulated with the Agenda. The LATMS document will be tabled at the meeting.)

To encourage public participation in the LATMS process a meeting was held at the Linwood Service Centre on 9 December 1998. A number of concerned residents and Board members attended to consider traffic safety improvements for inclusion in the LATMS. Other issues raised are also outlined in the list of concerns in the draft plan.

At the meeting in December 1998 the area to be covered by the LATMS extended from Buckleys Road to Dyers Road. It was found that this area was too large to deal with as one LATMS and the area has been divided in two using Hay Street as the new boundary. The Bromley LATMS covers from Hay Street to Dyers Road and the remainder of the area will be looked at in the future. (Agreement has been reached with the Bromley Residents Group for the second LATMS - Buckleys Road to Hay Street - to be called Eastgate).
