

13. CASHEL STREET BUS STOP

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Bus Stop and Shelters Subcommittee that a bus stop be installed in Cashel Street.

With the changes to the eastern bus routes and the opening of the bus exchange the bus service along Cashel Street was redirected south along Fitzgerald Avenue. New bus stops were placed in Fitzgerald Avenue but one of these has proved to be unsatisfactory for businesses near the Cashel Street intersection.

Council officers have negotiated with businesses near the Cashel Street Fitzgerald Avenue intersection and gained consent for a bus stop to be located just east of the traffic signals at the intersection.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend the following to the Bus stops and Shelters Subcommittee of the City Services Committee:

1. That the bus stop on the eastern side of Fitzgerald Avenue commencing at a point 8 metres measured in a northerly direction from a point opposite the northern kerbline of Lichfield street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 18 metres be removed.
2. That a bus stop be installed on the south side of Cashel Street commencing at a point 34.5 metres from its intersection with Fitzgerald Avenue and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 14.5 metres.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the recommendations be adopted.
