

## 8. CHARLESWORTH STREET – GIVE WAY

The purpose of this report is to gain Board approval for the installation of a “Give Way” control against Charlesworth Street at Ferry Road.

As part of the kerb and channel renewal in Charlesworth Street, the safety audit has highlighted the need for a control to be installed against Charlesworth Street at Ferry Road.

Ferry Road is a minor arterial and carries a large volume of traffic. Charlesworth Street is a local road and serves as an entrance to the Brookhaven subdivision.

A “Give Way” control against Charlesworth Street will improve safety at the intersection and will allow traffic on Ferry Road to clear the intersection quickly.

**Recommendation:** That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Charlesworth Street at its intersection with Ferry Road.

**Chairman’s Recommendation:** That the recommendation be adopted.
