

9. NAYLAND STREET AT MARRINER STREET – GIVE WAY

The purpose of this report is to gain Board approval for the installation of a “Give Way” control against Nayland Street at Marriner Street.

As part of the kerb and channel renewal in Nayland Street, the safety audit has highlighted the need for a control to be installed against Nayland Street at Marriner Street.

Marriner Street is a minor arterial and carries a large volume of traffic. Nayland Street is a local road and serves as an entrance to Richmond Hill.

A “Give Way” control against Nayland Street will improve safety at the intersection and will allow traffic on Marriner Street to clear the intersection quickly.

Recommendation: That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Nayland Street at its intersection with Marriner Street.

Chairman’s Recommendation: That the recommendation be adopted.
