## Heritage Hotel Tramway Lane Cathedral Square - Hagley Ward

A request has been received from the Heritage Hotel to name an accessway that runs along the south side of the old Government Building, from Tramway Lane to Cathedral Square. Until ten years ago, the accessway was a legal road named Customs Lane. (The Government Building housed the Customs Department, and the building was labelled as 'H M CUSTOMS' at one stage.) The legal road was stopped about ten years ago, and the land became part of the Heritage Hotel site.

The Hotel Management have requested an unusual name for the access, "**OGB Lane**" from Old Government Building. In their letter of application they state: "As the building is well known as the Old Government Building and fondly referred to as 'The OGB' we feel it would be fitting that the lane running behind the building be recognised as the OGB Lane. With the installation of nameplates and signposts as required we believe this will enhance the special nature of both the building and the lane".

**Recommendation:** That the Board decide whether "OGB Lane" is suitable for this accessway.
