The Environment Committee met on Thursday 30 August at 2.00 pm. The committee received the concept plans for the mural at Linwood Park that was designed at a recent legal arts workshop.

## **CONSULTATION**

When the matter was first raised the process that was given to the board was that consultation would take place before the design was drafted. Once the design had been drafted it would be presented to the local community board and appropriate committees.

The committee decided that consultation for this piece of work should take the form of community information in a positive manner with the history of the project and what has already occurred explained as part of this information. The Community Advocate would endeavour to get an article published in the September edition of City Scene. Local residents groups would also be sent information about the artwork.

The Committee resolved that:

- 1. Permission be given to the Legal Arts Team to put the concept that was presented to the committee on wall in Linwood park, together with Michael Slade painting part of it in a scenic, forest type scene with the crews being able to put their names in a small area beside their artwork.
- 2. That before the project commences the public will be informed through the Hagley/Ferrymead City Scene insert and other appropriate information publications/meetings.

Delia Walker raised issues relating to maintenance of the artwork once it is on the wall and whether it would be a temporary or permanent artwork. Delia agreed to check with Sharon Williams as to the maintenance issue. No guarantees could be given as to how long the artwork will stay on the wall.
