

5. BROADOAKS PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval for the installation of a part-time no stopping restriction in Eridge Place, Yelverton Place and Millway Place. All three cul-de-sac's are a part of a new subdivision called Broadoakes located at the top end of Major Aitken Drive.

At this stage both Eridge Place and Yelverton Place have only one completed home, and in Millway Place the owners are currently in the middle of constructing their new home.

Each one of these cul-de-sac's have become yet another playground for young people to congregate in vehicles late at night to do burnouts, drink copious amounts of alcohol, play loud music, vandalise fences and gates, and create an environment that is distressing to the residents living there. In the case of Millway Place where a house is being constructed the young people are vandalising and stealing from the building site.

It has been suggested that a parking restriction similar to that recently approved for Ernlea Terrace would offer the residents some relief. At the present time when the Police attend incidents and move along the vehicles and occupiers, the young people simply return once the Police have departed the scene.

The residents of Eridge Place, Yelverton Place and the owner of the property in Millway Place, currently under construction, are supportive of the initiative.

The proposed part-time no stopping restriction would be enforced between 10pm to 7am in each cul-de-sac. The Police have intimated that they would enforce the no stopping restriction.

- Recommendation:**
1. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited between 10pm and 7am on the east side of Eridge Place commencing at its intersection with Major Aitken Drive and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 88 metres.
 2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited between 10pm and 7am on the west side of Eridge Place commencing at its intersection with Major Aitken Drive and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 92.6 metres.
 3. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited between 10pm and 7am on the west side of Yelverton Place commencing at its intersection with Major Aitken Drive and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 96 metres.
 4. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited between 10pm and 7am on the east side of Yelverton Place commencing at its intersection with Major Aitken Drive and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 96 metres.
 5. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited between 10pm and 7am on the east side of Millway Place commencing at its intersection with Kenmuir Place and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 80 metres.
 6. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited between 10pm and 7am on the west side of Millway Place commencing at it intersection with Kenmuir Place and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 84 metres.
