

3. PETITIONS

BROAD PARK MACROCARPA TREES

A petition has been received from residents living near the Broad Park area requesting that the young macrocarpa trees on the east side of Broad Park are not cut down. A letter from residents referring the petition reads as follows:

“The Parks and Reserves department have been discussing the trees at Broad Park (North Beach). The residents surrounding the area strongly oppose the removal of the young macrocarpas.

This petition was collected in a short time. For any missing addresses the people were not at home or they had dogs on their property.

Only one person refused to sign.”
